34 families replied out of a possible 54.

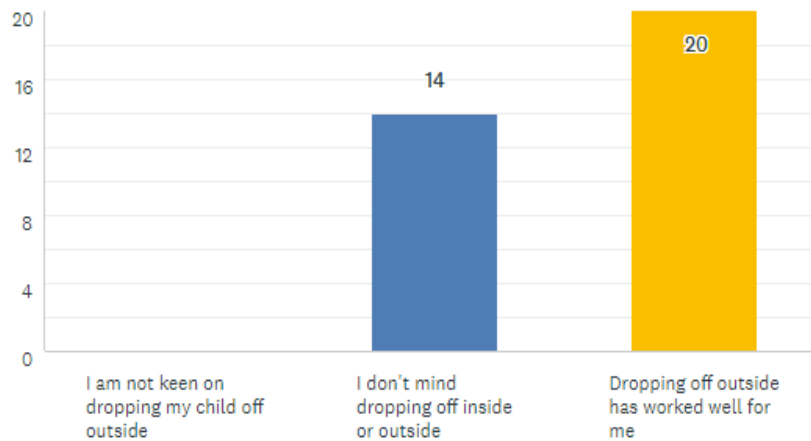
This year has been a global pandemic. We have had to change our practice and procedures. How confident have you felt about sending your child to Nursery, taking into account the changes we have made?

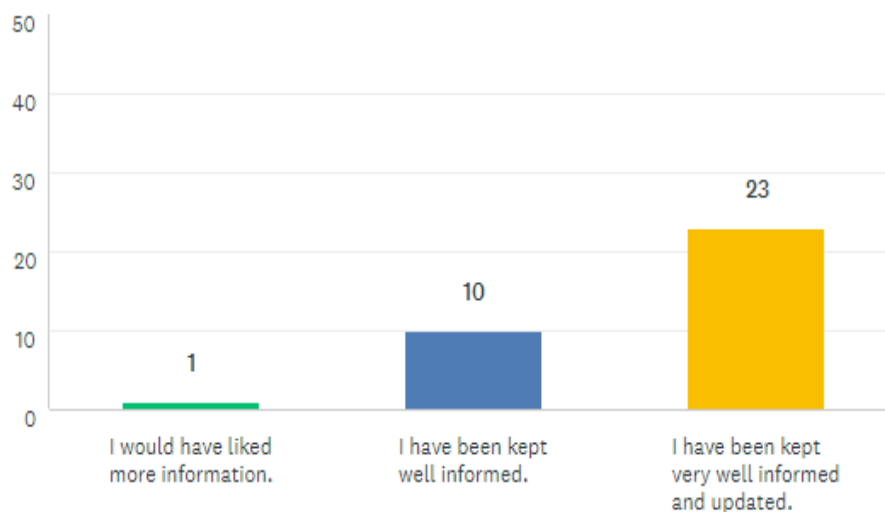

Please tell us your thoughts and ideas on attending our Nursery during the Covid pandemic, especially about the new way of dropping your child off to us.

I have been very pleased with the way everything was handled during the pandemic and was happy and confident sending my child. The new way of dropping off has worked well as it feels safe and organised.

I was initially worried about the idea of dropping off outside with it being a completely new setting, however it has worked very well. It's quick, easy and stress free

I have been very impressed, the nursery has handled everything amazingly. I have no concerns or complaints. It is a shame we couldn't drop off inside as it would have been nice but the staff made the parents feel very included during drop off and pick up times by having photo books outside and telling us the fun our babies had been doing that session.

It will be similar at school, so I think it is easy for kids to understand now before big step.

With [REDACTED] being very confident and happy, it has been lovely to just drop and go! I think it's a great idea. From my experience with 'clingy' children, it gives them an opportunity to quickly adjust to leaving their parents - as that has to happen eventually - so the sooner they learn it, the better!!

Amazing staff as always, they have adapted very well under the new conditions and not only makes us as parents feel safe to send our child, but our child also feels safe. Always amazing x

Efficient and more settling for the children (the most important thing!) but as a parent, not having so much interaction with other parents has been harder.

I am happy with the setting.

It's worked well and kept children, staff & parents safe at this moment in time

Every measure has been thought of to keep the kids safe from masks to dropping off outside of the building and marking the floor for social distancing purposes!

I have been very happy with dropping my child off outside. I think it has helped him to settle quicker. It is however sad that we no longer get to see the children's displays on the walls which we did when dropping off pre covid

I think dropping off outside nursery has been brilliant, it has made my child more independent and confident

I'm happy to drop my child off outside.

You have been amazing from start to finish

Dropping off my child outside with a new baby has been better for me as I can keep baby in pushchair or arms without going inside or signing any register. The nursery has been fantastic and offered a day back for my child who lost a day due to covid closure.

My daughter only started in January so we know no different, everything has been very well done and she's been so happy attending!

I have loved how nursery has been through this difficult time. I wouldn't change anything. Thank you for being supportive throughout.

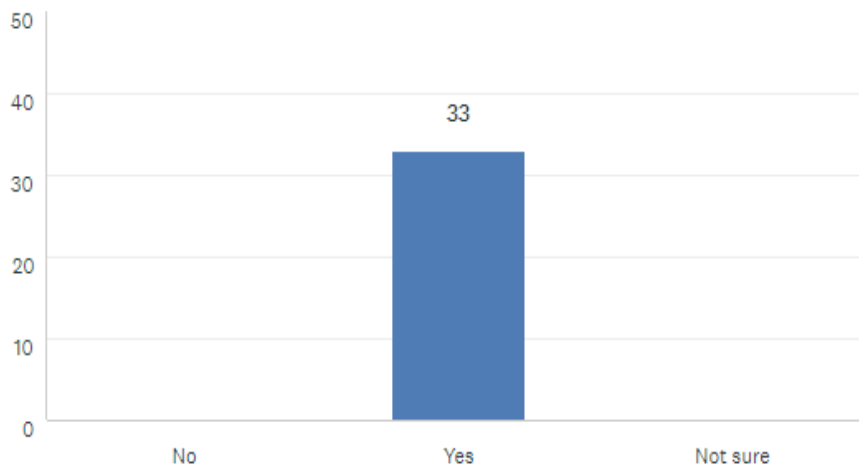
Worked very well.

I love tapestry and learning about what my daughter has been up to whilst at nursery

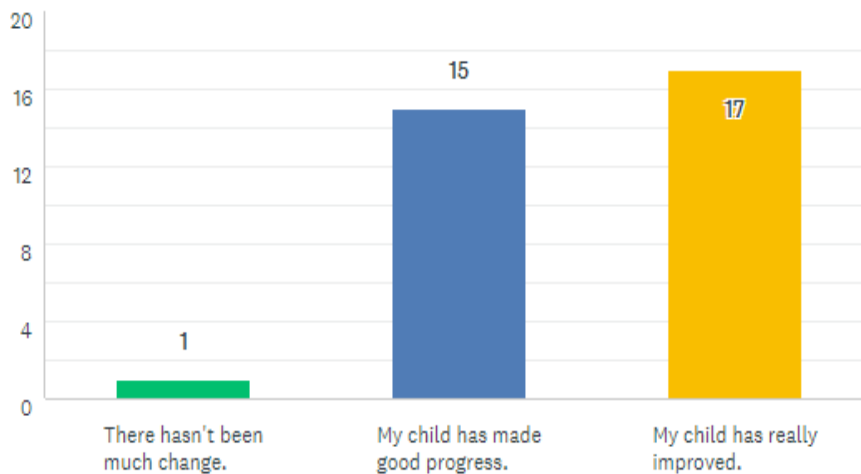
Very good way of seeing what they have been up to.

My child is always learning when in your setting from a friend's name to a staff member too songs and books.

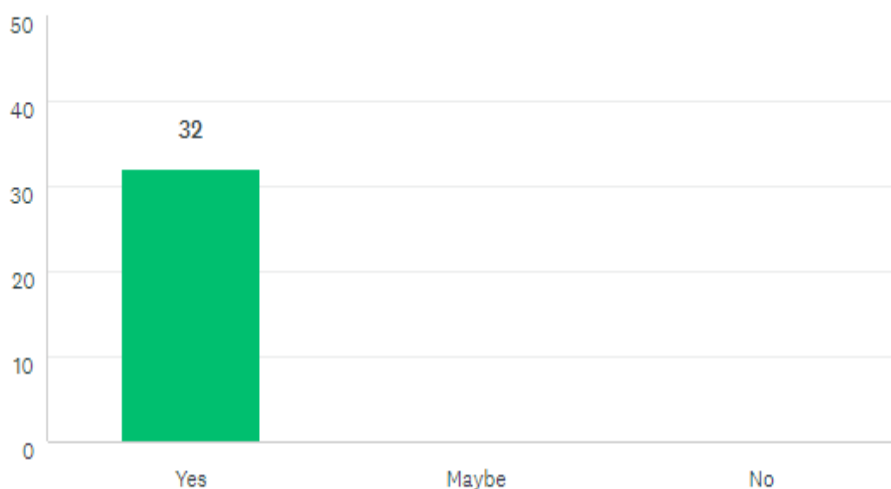
They have developed a wider range of vocabulary. Constructing sentences together with more confident

She has never struggled with communication but I feel that she has learned other valuable lessons at nursery

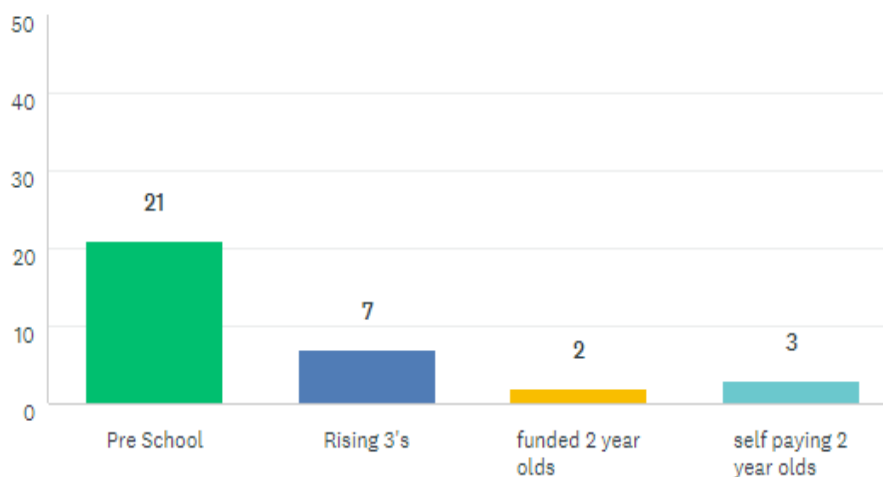
Would you recommend Beech Green Nursery to your family and friends?
